

Bathroom Protocol for Creation Corner Preschool

Toilet expectations are stated in the Creation Corner Parent Handbook (page 8). Please read and check the paragraph that corresponds with your child's age.

- ☐ By age three, children should be actively working at self-toileting. If assistance is needed, and your child asks for help, teachers will provide assistance, if written permission has been granted in writing by a parent. With this permission to offer assistance, two teachers will be present and the bathroom door will remain open while the child is using the toilet. We will assess the situation and give verbal instruction to see if the child can be self-reliant. If the child cannot be self-reliant, one teacher, wearing gloves, will help assist the child.

- ☐ Our goal at Creation Corner will be to help our Pre-K students become self-reliant in all aspects of using the toilet. However, we do understand that situations arise where some assistance may be needed. If assistance is needed, and your child asks for help, teachers will provide assistance, if written permission has been granted in writing by a parent. With this permission to offer assistance, two teachers will be present and the bathroom door will remain open while the child is using the toilet. We will assess the situation and give verbal instruction to see if the child can be self-reliant. If the child cannot be self-reliant, one teacher, wearing gloves, will help assist the child.
