#### **DRESS CODE**

#### While at camp, students and adults are asked to:

- Wear modest shorts! If shorts are considered too short or inappropriate by either Fuge Staff or First Students Staff, students are expected to change.
- Tank Tops/shirts with spaghetti straps, open backs, or excessive cutouts which expose torso and undergarments are NOT allowed.
- · Oversized shirts that cover shorts are not allowed.
- Closed-toe, closed-heel shoes are required for activities.

#### Make sure students do NOT pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person.
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations.
- Has spaghetti/small straps or open back, except for sleepwear.

#### THINGS TO PACK FOR CAMP

- · Linens, towels, pillow, blankets, twin sheets, fan
- · Water bottle you can refill and carry with you
- Closed-toe, closed-heel shoes
- Bible, notepad and pen
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap etc.)
- Sun protection
- Wrist Watch, to keep time if you don't have a phone!
- Spending money for travel lunch (Monday and Friday)
- Spending money for camp store and missions offering (optional)

#### **CELL PHONE POLICY**

Students may use their phone throughout the week except during LIFE Group, Prayer, Gathering, Worship, and Church Group Time. Any Adult Leader may take a student's phone if they are using their phones during inappropriate times.



#### **NIGHT LIFE**

Following the worship service, students will participate and experience an interactive set display both personally and with their church groups. This is often a powerful and profound night for students to reflect on their salvation, walk with God, sin struggles and relationships.

#### What will accommodations and room arrangements be like?

This depends on the location where our camp is hosted. The majority of Student Life Camp locations use dorm rooms with 2-4 beds and shared bathrooms or community bathrooms. Specific information will be shared with parents as the camp date approaches.

#### Can I send my Jr. High student to Student Life Camp?

Unfortunately, no. While Student Life allows 7th and 8th Grade students to attend their camp, we take our Jr. High students to Fuge Camp instead.

#### Who will be watching over my student while at camp?

From First Students, we bring one adult for every 5-7 students. These adults are screened, background-checked, and trained before attending camp.

#### What does the camp cost go toward?

We charge as close to the cost of camp as we can while being able to buy some small supplies for the camp that we often need along with a portion to supplement transportation cost.

#### Can I contact my student during the week of camp?

Of course! If your student has a phone you can contact them throughout the week. If not, LifeGroup leaders will be able to have constant communication with parents and students.
