Dress Code

While at camp, students and adults are asked to:

- Wear modest shorts – if shorts are considered too short or inappropriate by either Fuge Staff or First Students staff, students are expected to change.
- Sleeveless shirts/tank tops are allowed during day-time activities.
- Shirts with spaghetti straps, open backs or excessive cutouts which expose torso and undergarments are not allowed.
- Oversize shirts that cover shorts are not allowed.
- Closed-toe, closed-heel shoes are required for activities.

Make sure students do NOT pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs.
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person.
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations.
- Has spaghetti/small straps or open back, except for sleepwear.

Things To Pack For Camp

- Linens, towels, pillow and blankets
- Water bottle you can refill and carry with you
- Closed-toe, closed-heel shoes (for Mission Site & Recreation)
- Bible, notepad and pen
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Sun protection
- Spending money for travel lunch (Monday and Saturday)
- Spending money for camp store and missions offering (optional)

Cell Phone Policy

Students may use their phone throughout the week except during Morning Celebration, Bible Study, Worship, Night Life, Mission Sites. Any Adult Leader may take a student's phone if they are using their phones during inappropriate times.

Frequently Asked Questions

Who do I contact if I have any questions about Fuge Camp?

What will accommodations and room arrangements be like?

This depends on the location where our camp is hosted. The majority of Fuge Camps locations are dorm rooms with 2-4 beds and shared bathrooms or community bathrooms. Specific information will be shared with parents as the camp date approaches.

Will there be high school students at Fuge?

Yes. Fuge is not just for Jr. High students but we only take our completed 6th-8th graders to Fuge Camp. Our group is together the majority of camp so your student's interaction with a high school student or students from another church will be minimal.

Who will be watching over my student while at camp?

From First Students, we attempt to bring one adult for every 5-7 students. These adults are screened, background checked, and trained before attending camp. Fuge Staffers are available throughout the camp to help students and also follow strict background checks and training.

Is there any financial assistance available?

Yes! This year, we are starting something we're calling the HelpGo Camp Scholarship. This is a specific scholarship that provides financial assistance because cost should never be a reason why a student cannot attend camp. When registering your student, a form will be available to request the HelpGo Camp Scholarship. For any questions, please contact the First Students team at fbcostudents@fbcofallon.org.

What does the camp cost go toward?

We charge as close to the cost of camp as we can while being able to buy some small supplies for the camp that we often need. We do not charge students for transportation or other costs that could add to the cost of registration.
