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WHAT IS SWERVE AND WHERE DO I FIT IN?

Swerve is the student leadership team of First Students. Swerve students are actively involved in our student ministry from Sunday mornings to Sunday nights. Our team is broken down into four areas:

CONNECT TEAM

Creating a culture in which students feel comfortable and welcome, Connect Team members will specifically connect with guests, first-timers, families, and anyone else who needs to be connected or followed-up.

CREATIVE TEAM

Using various types of social media and creative content to help students be engaged to their student ministry, church, community, and each other, the Creative Team drives a lot!

ENVIRONMENTS TEAM

Creating an environment where students can engage with and experience God through the Word, community, and various elements, the Environment Team members will serve logistically with a focus on HS and JHM setup and leader support.

TECH TEAM

Tech team is a vital part of our youth ministry. Students will be training on use of cameras, soundboards, lighting systems and anything that involves tech from Sunday Morning to Sunday Night.

EXPECTATIONS

Being held to a higher standard means there are Biblical mandates you're expected to follow and live out. All Student Leaders will be held to these standards:

- Attend Sunday Morning LIFE Group as a swerve team member 15-20 minutes before the LIFE Group hour that you attend.
- Attend Sunday Youth Night Swerve meetings at 6:15pm
- Strives for a consistent Bible study and prayer life
- Faithful to church and actively participates in a Sunday morning Life Group
- Able to faithfully attend Student Worship services
- Able to attend weekly meeting (6:15pm during your Student Worship night)
- Reaches out to friends and peers who are not saved/unchurched
- Abstains from alcohol and situations where alcohol is present
- Maintains modesty in appearance, conduct, and speech
- Supportive of leadership
- Actively attends 75% or more of FS Events
- Actively supports and promotes FS events (social media, word of mouth, etc.)
- Able to commit to at least one school year

PURPOSE

We will help our peers understand their calling as a follower of Christ and encourage them to live it out.

BELIEFS

Understand and affirm what we believe at FBCO:

- Put God first in your finances, pursuing the tithe (Genesis 28:20-22, Acts 2:42-47, 2 Corinthians 9:6-9), Avoid viewing pornography (Matthew 5:28)
- Stay away from excessive alcohol and drug use (Ephesians 5:18, Galatians 5:19-21).
- Use your speech to uplift and edify those around you (Matthew 15:11, Ephesians 4:29, Titus 2:7-8).
- Use social media responsibly (Matthew 18:6, Hebrews 13:18). Practice a biblical view of sexuality (Romans 13:13, 1 Corinthians 6:9-10, 18).
- Commit to sex only within marriage
- Avoid being active in or promoting a homosexual lifestyle
- Belief that biological sex determines gender

- Make sure new here students fill out the new here card
- Take new-here students to LIFE Group Table.
- General welcoming and assistance




